

PORT OF NEWPORT

ORDINANCE NO. 5, 1971

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF WHEELED PASSENGER VEHICLES OR DEVICES ON THE WALKWAYS AND FINGER PIERS OF THE PORT OF NEWPORT DOCKS IN LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON; PRESCRIBING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PORT OF NEWPORT, LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to operate, ride, or be carried upon any vehicle or device designed for or capable of carrying an operator or passenger, upon the walkways or finger piers of any Port of Newport Dock, in Lincoln County, Oregon.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall pay a fine not to exceed two hundred and fifty dollars or be imprisoned for a term not to exceed thirty days, or both.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Port of Newport and its citizens, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon adoption.

This ordinance is declared adopted this 19th day of July, 1971.
