

ORDINANCE NO. 3, 1969

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE LOADING, UNLOADING OR TRANSPORTING BY WHEELED VEHICLES OF FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS OVER PORT OF NEWPORT DOCKS IN YAQUINA BAY, LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON: PRESCRIBING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PORT OF NEWPORT, LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to load, unload or transport flammable liquids by wheeled vehicles from, over and across any Port of Newport Dock in Yaquina Bay, Lincoln County, Oregon.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall pay a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars or be imprisoned not to exceed thirty days, or in the discretion of the Court, may be punished by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Port of Newport and its Newport citizens, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective when signed by the Vice President of the Port of Newport.
