ORDINANCE NO. 1961 - 1

BE IT ORDAINED that the following regulations governing the Port of Newport property in Depoe Bay, Oregon be adopted:


SECTION 1. All commercial enterprises on Port docks and property used by the public including buying, selling, soliciting and carrying of charters and passengers for hire shall be prohibited unless authorized by the Harbor Master.


SECTION 2. The Harbor Master shall have authority to enforce this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be interpreted to prevent repairmen or other artixans from boarding boats for maintenance and repair.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after December 11, 1961.
